Food insecurity contributes to health problems including depression, adult obesity, and overall health problems.

At Indianhead Community Action Agency's Connections Store & More we would like to help. At our Food Pantry we offer fresh vegetables (when available) canned fruits & vegetables, cereals, grains & protein items plus many other choices.

Our food pantry has income guidelines as stated on the back page.

Our pantry is open Tues-Thurs 9am-4pm and the 3rd Saturday of every month 9am-2pm. Proof of your address in Washburn Co is required once each year and an ID must be shown to pick up your food each month. A proxy form is available if you are unable to get to the pantry. If you qualify Faith in Action or the ADRC may be able to help you with picking up your food. We don't want anyone in our county to go hungry.
