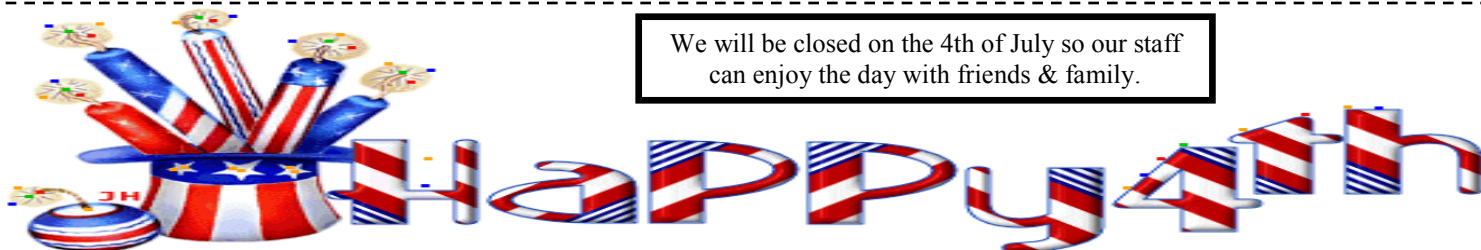

July 17, 2018 @ 6:00 pm & September 8, 2018 @ 10:00 am

Meet Me in the Garden is a series of educational events during the growing season at the Spooner Agriculture Research Station Teaching and Display Garden. The events are led by Master Gardener Volunteers, Summer Garden Interns, and the UW-Extension Horticulture Agent. Please bring your own chair for the Meet Me in the Garden Series. The Display and Teaching Garden can be found across from the Sheep Research Facility at N5264 Orchard Lane. Orchard Lane is located 1 ½ miles east of Spooner on Highway 70 or ½ mile west of Hwy 70/53 Interchange. In the case of inclement weather, programs will be held at the Station Building at W6646 Hwy 70, Spooner.

NEWBORN NESTS

A Newborn Nest is a sturdy cardboard box with a mattress pad and fitted sheet. They provide a safe place for babies to sleep. You may need one if:

- You have no crib or pack n play at home.
- You have a crib or pack n play, but it doesn't fit in your bedroom, and you would like to have your baby close by for the first couple months.
 - Your baby goes to Grandma's or a neighbor's, and they don't have a crib or pack n play.
- You know you may be traveling and staying at a hotel or a relative's house and want your baby to have a safe place to sleep.

To get your Newborn Nest at no cost to you, contact the Washburn County Health Department at 715-635-4400.

CodeRED is a FREE emergency notification service provided to all residents within Washburn County that will notify you of emergency information through phone calls, text messages, emails and social media. The system will be used to keep you informed of local events that may immediately impact your safety. As a local resident, Washburn County Sheriff's Office & Emergency Management encourages you to take action and register your cell phone for this service and verify your home location during the enrollment process so we may target notifications that directly impact your home or business.
